

ILLINOS HIGHWAYS AND FREEWAYS THAT COULD ERECT ATTRACTION SIGNS

These are the Interstate highways and other full freeways where Tourism Attraction signs may be considered subject to available room, number of logo signs, etc. Opportunities for signing will be limited at a number of interchanges on qualifying highways in the Chicago and St. Louis areas principally due to lack of space for additional signs.

- Interstates 24, 55, 57, 64, 70, 72, 74, 172, 180, 190, 255, 270, 280, 290, 474
- I-39 from Bloomington to I-90 at Rockford.
- I-80 from Iowa to Kedzie Ave. (Exit 154) and, possibly, the Torrence Ave. interchange (Exit 161)
- I-88 from I-80 to Illinois 40 (Exit 41)
- I-94 from I-80 to Dundee Rd. (Exit 29)
- I-90 from the Skyway to I-190
- Illinois 53 from I-290 to Lake-Cook Rd.
- Illinois 6 from I-474 to Mossville (Exit 9)
- Illinois 255 from I-270 to Illinois 143
- Illinois 394 from I-80 to US 30
- US 20 (through Elgin) from Lake St. to Randall Rd.
- US 20 (around Rockford) from I-39 to Business 20 east of Rockford.
- US 34 (around Galesburg) from I-74 to Illinois 164
- US 67 from I-72 to Illinois 104 at Jacksonville

Signing cannot be placed at Interchanges between two freeways such as the interchange with I-57 and I-80, or between a freeway and a toll highway such as the interchange between I-90 and I-290.
